Award Application and Process

The application process is free and open to all individuals who are committed to building communities through service. An individual may complete and submit an application that evaluates the nominee’s efforts in making an impact on our community. Nominees will also be evaluated on contributions, achievements and the responses to specific questions (see below)

Applicants are **required** to submit a photograph (at least 300dpi resolution). You must complete the attached form and on a separate sheet of paper, tell us in detail (500 words or less, typed) of the nominee’s activities and community involvement (see below).
